



PERMIT GUIDANCE WORKSHEET

This worksheet is meant to serve as guidance for determining if you need a District permit.

STORMWATER – *If the site is covered by a stormwater plan which meets District standards the site does not need to obtain a permit.*

Resort is defined as a building or group of buildings located adjacent to any waterbody for purposes of providing convenient access to the waterbody, and held out to the public to be a place where sleeping accommodations are furnished to the public, primarily to those seeking recreation. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | <input type="checkbox"/> | c) Are you expanding or replacing an existing structure at an existing resort? |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | <input type="checkbox"/> | d) If you answered Yes to c), is your project increasing the structure by less than 2,000 ft ² or 200% of the existing size? If yes, Administrator Approval may be applicable. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | <input type="checkbox"/> | e) Is your project a new Planned Unit Development (PUD)? (i.e., residential development or cluster development). |

If you answered **Yes** to any question above, a permit is required from the District.

EROSION CONTROL – *This Rule does not apply to ordinary agricultural practices.*
